### The Latest:

A surveyor will be on site sometime this month to conduct a field boundary survey and setting stakes on the property line from Units 2 - 36. After the survey, there will be a new boundary fence installed in this location. There was originally a stockade fence that ran this property line as a requirement per the Town of Windsor Locks land records for the Woodlands. Over time this fence has deteriorated and MUST be replaced or the Association could start to incur fines.

The annual dumpster will be delivered on October 23rd and will stay until it is filled. Please remember to not put in appliances, mattresses or electronics.

A reminder that trash should not be put out until 6:00 the night before and all trash receptacles should be brought in on trash day. Receptacles should be placed side by side in front of the green lines. The green lines were put there to alleviate damage done to the garages when the truck lifting arm picks up the tipper barrels. Also, please be sure any bulky items are NOT put to the curb until the night prior to pick-up. It is unit owner responsibility to call All American Waste to tell them what the items are and where they are located. Try to put them at the corner of Meadow Lane and your court so they are easy for the driver to find.



Don't forget to grab the flyers by the mailboxes.

Furnace Cleaning and Filters - If you don't replace your filter as recommended, it becomes overwhelmed with dust and creates a strain on your HVAC system. This might increase your gas and electric bill or worse, cause irreparable damage to your system. Please be sure to have your HVAC system serviced yearly. Many of the HVAC systems are reaching end of life and could experience a cracked heat exchanger causing CO2 to leak into your unit and potentially be deadly.



### Speed Bumps

You have probably noticed by now we have new speed bumps along Meadow Lane. These speed bumps were installed in response to the enormous amount of speeding happening at the Woodlands by not only residents, but resident's friends, relatives and delivery trucks.



Signs have been put up and the bumps will be painted yellow.
